

A MESSAGE TO OUR FRIENDS

"By meeting budget goals, managing costs, and enhancing care programs, we've set the stage for even greater things to come."

This year has been full of meaningful progress and exciting achievements at The Virginia Home. Thanks to thoughtful financial planning, we've been able to strengthen our foundation, improve daily operations, and create a vibrant, connected community for both residents and staff.

We've hit some incredible milestones along the way. By meeting budget goals, managing costs, and enhancing care programs, we've set the stage for even greater things to come. Morale among residents and staff is at an all-time high, and the strides we've made in building an engaging workplace culture are reflected in lower staff turnover and stronger employee engagement.

Financially, The Virginia Home is in a strong position, thanks to disciplined management and forward-thinking decisions. This year, we reached both our operating and capital budget goals while making key investments in our future. We allocated \$16 million to a capital reserve account bolstering our long-term security. Meanwhile, our focus on responsible debt management reduced our balance to \$5.5 million.

We also found ways to save in our day-to-day operations. For instance, switching insurance carriers cut our workers' compensation premiums by a third, saving \$33,000 this year, and changes to our waste management services are saving an additional \$75,000 annually. These efforts reflect our commitment to financial sustainability and smart resource management.

Big things ahead! Board Chair Laura Stewart and CEO Doug Vaughan review the exciting renderings for our new facility—bringing the future of The Virginia Home to life! Life at The Virginia Home has been thriving in so many ways. Residents enjoyed meaningful experiences like vacations to Sandbridge and Smith Mountain Lake and outings to Altria Theatre, plus numerous cultural attractions and participation in the Special Olympics. The launch of our PALS program (Personal Assistant Loving Support) has been especially impactful, enriching the lives of some of our most vulnerable residents.



We've also focused on supporting our incredible team. In August, we introduced a 4% wage increase along with targeted raises for LPNs to help us attract and retain top talent. As a result, our annual staff turnover rate dropped from 27% in 2023 to just 19.2% in 2024—far better than the state average of 51.2%! Employee engagement also rose from 65% to 78%, thanks to initiatives like our annual health fair and professional development programs. These efforts are all about fostering a workplace where everyone feels valued and supported.

Our greatest challenge this past year has been planning for our future while upholding the high standards that define The Virginia Home. Thoughtful strategies have been essential to ensure the exceptional care and safety at the core of our mission. At the same time, this period of transition brings exciting opportunities for growth and innovation. With a steadfast commitment to resident-centered care and staff well-being, we are ready to embrace the next chapter.

Speaking of the next chapter—here we are! As you may know, The Virginia Home is embarking on an exciting journey to establish a state-of-the-art campus in Hanover County. While our current facility, built in 1930, has served us well, it's time to overcome the challenges of our aging infrastructure and create room for growth.

The new campus will sit on a beautiful 70-acre site and represents a \$128 million investment in our future. It will increase residential capacity by 30, bringing our total to 160 residents, with room for more in the future. The modern one-story design eliminates stairs and elevators, creating a safer, more accessible environment. Residents will enjoy larger, brighter, and more comfortable rooms, and the introduction of a comprehensive Day Program will allow us to serve 55–60 additional participants, addressing our waitlist and expanding our reach in the community.

The facility's innovative design incorporates advanced technology and thoughtful features, like shared bathrooms and plans for multi-person units to offer supported independent living options. This campus will truly redefine what's possible for our residents and staff, and we're thrilled to see this vision come to life.

Looking ahead to 2025, we're excited to build on this year's momentum. Our goals include further improving staff satisfaction, advancing our Capital Campaign in support of our "big dream," and refining internal policies to better serve our community. Above all, we'll remain focused on resident care, ensuring every decision reflects their well-being and dignity.

None of this would be possible without the incredible support of our residents, families, employees, donors, volunteers and board members. Your dedication to The Virginia Home means everything to us, and we're so grateful for all you do to make this community thrive.





Eligibility

Any Virginia resident who is at least 18 years of age may seek admission. Generally, they must qualify for nursing home care under the laws of Medicaid and be diagnosed with an irreversible physical disability. At present, the average age of our residents is 55. About one-third of our residents are from Central Virginia, with the remainder representing every part of the state.

Services

Unlike traditional nursing homes, which are typically custodial facilities for the elderly, The Virginia Home is much more. The Home provides rehabilitative services, including occupational, recreational, speech and physical therapy; social services; round-the-clock nursing care; and individualized nutritional services. Laundry services, housekeeping, and wheelchair repair and maintenance services are also provided. A full-time Medical Director is among a team of 240 professional caregivers and staff.

Cost


Round-the-clock care is costly, and operational expenses increase annually. Based on a daily cost of \$544 per resident in 2024, The Virginia Home was able to provide the highest quality care and services possible.

Funding

Few residents have the financial resources to completely pay for their care. For all but a few residents, financial assistance from federal and state sources administered through Medicaid covers most of the cost of care. However, many of the special programs that enrich and enhance the quality of life for residents are provided by contributions, including ancillary health services, community cultural opportunities, holiday celebrations, special events and full-time chaplaincy and music therapy programs.

Tax Deductibility of Gifts

The Virginia Home is incorporated as a private, non-profit organization under IRS code 501(c)(3), and gifts are tax deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law. Contributions are used to help defray the costs assumed by The Home for the daily care of our residents unless otherwise specified.
